# RCF Innovate for Good winners named Sept. 14

**R**ose Community Foundation has announced nine finalists in the youth-adult partnership category of philanthropic challenge, Innovate for Good 2016.

Four youth awardees, whose projects do not involve an adult partner, will be announced at an awards event on Sept. 14 — alongside the finalists in the youth-adult partnership category, which will be voted on to receive funding to implement their projects.

All 13 projects have advanced to this stage for their fresh perspective, innovation, potential for impact and insight responding to the ques-

tion: “What idea could you bring to life to empower youth to make the community better?”

The foundation will provide \$250,000 in grants and support to the winning ideas.

“We are impressed by the innovative ideas that came in following our challenge to the greater Denver area,” says Lisa Robinson, RCF trustee and chair of the innovate for good committee.

On Sept. 14, RCF will host a celebration where attendees will hear live pitches from the youth-adult partnership finalists and vote for winning projects.
