DONOR DEVELOPMENT: Donors and aligned funders contributed \$7,719,820 to the Foundation, fourteen new advised funds were established and 8 new planned gifts were made. FUND DISTRIBUTIONS: Donors' recommended grants totaled \$3,227,143 to a broad range of community interests. The Foundation's philanthropy advisors help donors articulate values, narrow their philanthropic focus and identify goals and the impact they want to make through giving, as well as facilitate giving circles. ENDOWMENT SERVICES: The Foundation received \$12,234,840 in contributions for new and existing permanent endowment and designated funds for local nonprofit organizations. The Foundation paid out \$10,326,324 to local nonprofit organizations who have established permanent endowments and designated funds at the Foundation.
