



# ORGANIZATIONS PROMOTING CIVIC ENGAGEMENT

These organizations, all Rose Community Foundation grantees, work to elevate the perspectives and priorities of those furthest from opportunity through voter participation, community organizing around local issues, and civic leadership development programs.

**Advocacy Rising:** Helping leaders for social change win on bold policy by expanding their advocacy-specific knowledge, tools, and skills.

**The Alliance Center:** Convenes leaders of environmental and social movements to advance solutions for a thriving planet.

**Colorado Circles for Change:** Working to end the school to prison pipeline, the criminalization of youth of color, breaking generational cycles of trauma, and healing and empowering the next generation of leaders.

**Colorado Civic Engagement Roundtable:** A coalition of 50 grassroots organizations working to foster a more equitable, just, and inclusive state where all Coloradans can participate in democracy and have a voice in the decisions that affect them.

**Colorado Latino Leadership, Advocacy & Research Organization:** Empowering Latino communities through leadership development, advocacy, and policy research to strengthen Colorado.

**Colorado Youth Congress:** A statewide youth leadership organization supporting young people as they seek to use leadership, advocacy and partnerships to advance wellbeing and justice.

**Community Resource Center:** Supporting, strengthening and galvanizing changemakers across the nonprofit ecosystem, working together to create a more equitable Colorado.

**Cultivando:** Cultivating community leadership to advance health equity through collaboration, advocacy, and policy change.

**Elevated Denver via Trailhead Institute:** Creating collaborative spaces where community members with lived experience and individuals from business, government, and nonprofits come together to share stories and critically examine housing and homelessness in Denver.

**Latina Initiative Colorado:** Working to increase the impact and influence of Latina voters by promoting and implementing culturally responsive, relevant, and inclusive communication, education, and voter engagement strategies.

**League of Women Voters of Colorado:** Fostering a democracy where every person has the desire, the right, the knowledge, and the confidence to participate. Programs include voter registration, nonpartisan education, advocacy training and opportunities for activism.

**Mi Familia Vota:** Building Latino political power by expanding the electorate, strengthening local infrastructures, and leading year-round voter engagement.

**New Era Colorado Foundation:** Harnessing young people's political power to create a Colorado that serves all people.

**Out Boulder County:** Facilitating connection, advocacy, education, research and programs to ensure LGBTQ+ people and communities thrive in Boulder County and beyond.

**Together Colorado:** Empowering people to strengthen and transform their communities through community organizing.

**Transformative Leadership for Change:** Facilitating a year-long fellowship for BIPOC leaders in social justice organizations that are working on nonpartisan civic engagement efforts that help to build power for historically disenfranchised communities throughout Greater Denver.
